Parties were introduced by a mutual acquaintance and traveled to Ankara, Turkey from their respective countries to get married on November 21, 2014 after which they returned to their respective countries. Respondent lied and withheld material information about her background to hasten the marriage, gain spousal sponsorship, and speed up her immigration application. Further, since her arrival to Canada on November 3, 2015, Respondent has continually and methodically subjected the Claimant to physical, emotional, and psychological cruelty and denigrated and defamed him socially and professionally. - It is impossible to obtain a certificate of marriage or registration of marriage because:  
Both civil and [REDACTED] (religious) ceremonies took place in Ankara, Turkey. Respondent retains various items of Claimant's personal property and documents and when asked several times during the ten months, has declined to surrender them. These include documents such as his birth certificate, passport, and both original marriage certificates. The current political situation in Turkey, prohibits traveling to that country to obtain replacement marriage certificates, and so far, efforts at recruiting a representative remotely who is acceptable to Turkish authorities have been unsuccessful. On March 29, 2017, a formal demand letter was served on Respondent for the items she has withheld. Should she surrender either or both marriage certificates, they will certainly be submitted. Meanwhile, copies of both civil and religious marriage certificates and English translation of the religious marriage certificate are being filed with this form.
